I am happy to develop using Flex/Flash Builder or the Flash environment and am also happy to code in AS2 or AS3. I am currently building a video player at TVNZ using the Adobe 'Open Source Media framework' (OSMF).

I have decent PHP and CSS skills and can create and maintain MySQL databases, configure Apache sites and successfully use version control systems.
